What is Kvöldstund?

Kvöldstund means “evening hour” in Icelandic — a time to wind down, sit together, and talk.

We invite guests to join a local host in their own home for a warm, friendly evening of stories and snacks. No stage, no screens — just people around a table.

How it Works:

- 1 host, 2–6 guests
- 2-hour evening (20:00–22:00 recommended)
- Tea, coffee, and traditional cakes or treats
- Honest, informal conversations about local life
- Guests pre-book online or via tourism office

Who Can Host?

- Anyone with a cozy home and a story to tell
- Farmers, crafters, retirees, artists, shopkeepers
- Hosts decide their own availability, prices, and topics
- English not required to be perfect — warmth matters more
